The landward boundary was defined as: * generally 1 km landward of the western boundary of the coastal waters of the State; * generally 1km landward around any bay, estuary, coastal lake or lagoon; * follows the length of any coastal river inland generally at a distance of 1km from each bank of the river; * to 1km beyond the limit of any recognised mangroves or tidal limit and; * is shown to the nearest cadastral boundary or easily recognisable physical boundary. The Coastal Zone was extended in Nov 05 to include the Greater Metropolitan Region (Newcastle to Shellharbour inclusive).
